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Adult Learning is it similar to student learning?

Malcolm Knowles research suggests a few things:

- There is no single theory of learning that can be applied to all adults.
- Moves from dependency to increasing self-directedness as he/she matures and can direct his/her own learning.
- Create a climate that supports transformative learning.
- Know your students and the types of learning activities that most appeal to them.
- Develop and use learning activities that explore and expose different points of view.

Start with the end in mind

During the Summer of 2021 we conducted a 6 week workshop for African American Males and Pre-Service teachers from Kent State University. The focus was on Media and the negative portrayal of African American Boys/Men.



Through this program we set the following goals:

- Show pre-service teachers strategies to connect all learning to students <u>SCL and</u> <u>SEL</u>.
- **□** Help students improve their writing skills
- Connect this work to teacher credibility Highlight media manipulation over time.

100% of pre-service teachers stated that their negative views about black males came from media vs personal encounter (10 Students 6 White Female, 4 White Males).


100% of pre-service teachers stated that black males weren't visibly included in the curriculum they were taught as students.


100% of pre-service teachers stated that they never had a personal negative experience with black males.


100% of pre-service teachers stated that they didn't feel like cultural diversity was a point of emphasis during their educational experience.



Blended Perspective of the entire audience


