- Title of poster session that shows it will be of interest to OCTEO attendees
- Name, institutional affiliation, mailing address, phone, and email of presenter
- Brief description of content or focus of research or findings (approximately 25 words) to be used in the conference program
- Justification for the poster session in the following areas (250 words max):
 - How does the topic interest the attendees of the Conference?
 - How does the content of your poster/presentation impact the attendees?
- **Attendee Demographics:**
 - OCTEO attracts 275-300 teacher educators from public and private schools of education from across Ohio. This includes Deans, Tenured Professors, Field Directors, and students from undergrad through PhD candidates.
- **Format**
 - Poster sessions will be hosted for one hour during the OCTEO Networking Reception on Thursday March 30 from 5:00 – 6:00pm
 - All presenters accepted will be registered for free and welcome to enjoy the Reception food and beverages
 - Printed poster on rigid substrate to be displayed on a lightweight easel
 - 48"x36" maximum landscape or horizontal format
 - Easels will be provided as well as free wi-fi
 - All poster proposals will be evaluated by the OCTEO Program Committee

All presenters must register for the conference and be affiliated with one of the OCTEO organizations: (OATE, OACTE, OAPCTE, SUED, OFDF) or be a conference sponsor. Registration cost is \$50 -- \$175; students and poster session presenter can register for free.

Presentations should be planned for one hour 5-6pm Thursday March 30, 2017.
Audience size is anticipated to be 20-40 participants per session.
