Active contribution to the department's accreditation process is also expected. Particular attention will be given to candidates who bring global and diverse perspectives to the department. Three years of teaching experience in grades 7-12 is required. Teaching licensure/certification in social studies, mathematics, or language arts is preferred. Ph.D. or Ed.D. required (ABD considered).
