

March 2020

University remained remote during Summer 2020

Pilot of remote clinical experience





Fall 2020

- Migration to remote offerings
- Internal adjustments
 - <u>Website</u>
 - <u>Blackboard</u>
 - Handbook
 - Staff roles
 - Attendance procedures
- External adjustments
 - Accessible remote platforms (zoom, google classroom, google forms, Youtube)
 - Learning Labs
 - Faculty support
 - Communication with families



Spring 2021

- Expansion of offerings
 - pre-pandemic: ~Four course sections per semester (~35 tutors, ~50 tutees)
 - Fall, 2020: Eight course sections (~70 tutors, ~100 tutees)
 - Spring, 2021: Fourteen course sections (~150 tutors, ~160 tutees)
- Center Initiatives
 - Open Sessions
 - Remote Teaching Certification



Fall 2021

- Merging the old with the new
 - Back to in-person
 - Remote offerings
- The CLC is still on the "grow"
 - Fundraising
 - Research and dissemination
 - Tutoring Outreach Program (TOP)





Lessons learned

- We need to be responsive to community needs.
- The "new normal" is anything but, and that's okay.
 - Flexibility is imperative
 - Hybrid options are challenging but necessary
- The Center is valuable to both families and CSU students.
